While the case hung in uncertainty, we threw ourselves into the work. The medical office and counseling rooms were remodeled, paperwork was updated, and preparations for the new medical office license were nearly complete. Yet, a question remained: What would the Ministry decide?

Now, the answer sat in my trembling hands. Slowly, I opened the envelope and began to read. Line by line, my heart lifted—until finally, with tears of relief and joy, I realized what it meant: **the case was archived!** The charges were dropped. No inspection; no fines! Praise God for His faithfulness and protection over this ministry!
