My Goal and Purpose remain the same - "Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit to abound to your account" (Philippians 4:17).

Dear Prayer Partners and Ministry Supporters!

There's no other way to put it! I am humbled. I am amazed! I am truly grateful and thankful. A few weeks ago, I wrote to you a Prayer, Praise, and PRESS Fund letter. I shared some of the responses to my "Dr. Mike's Daily Prescriptions" made possible by my PRESS Fund supporters. Here's what I shared with you concerning the PRESS Fund.

The 2025-2026 PRESS Fund Goal. My faithful prayer and financial partners make my ministry possible. My faithful prayer and once-a-year PRESS Fund partners help to specifically underwrite the costs of this unusual ministry. These funds are the business projected costs of doing this ministry.

The PR stands for Professional Reimbursement. This covers the yearly expense of producing and mailing prayer letters, purchasing supplies, ink cartridges, occasional books purchased to be loaned or given in counseling situations, cell phone fees, etc. The goal for PR was \$2,000.

The E stands for the physical Equipment of the website ministry and includes the cost of internet fees to host my domain, the MailChimp monthly expense to email 13,200 Daily Prescriptions each month to my subscribers as well as the laying aside of a portion toward computer updates in the future. This year I had to update my very out-of-date cell phone which is used around 75% of the time for ministry. A portion of the equipment funds will be used to reimburse the purchase of the new cell phone. The goal for the Equipment portion of my ministry was \$1500.

The **SS** stands for **Supplemental Support**. When I try to estimate my support needs into a monthly figure, I have always found that the supplemental support helps immensely. **The goal of the supplemental support this year was \$2,500**. Combining the Professional Reimbursement, the Equipment fund and the Supplemental Support, the 2025-2026 goal was **\$6,000**.

You read the letter.

You prayed about this need.

Today I am writing this THANKSGIVING and CELEBRATION letter. This is the earliest that the funding of the PRESS Funds has ever come in and even exceeded the goal of \$6,000! As of November 3rd, a grand total of twenty-six partners have contributed \$7,775.31! I am so very thankful and blessed. I think I am feeling like the Apostle Paul must have felt when he wrote to the church family at Philippi and said, "I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer

of mine making request for you all with joy, for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this very thing, that He Who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ; just as it is right for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart" (Philippians 1:3-7). He was so thankful for them and rejoiced in their fellowship in the gospel.

Some are wondering if it is too late to be part of the PRESS Fund. I realize that some folks look forward to participating in the PRESS Fund in year-end giving. Is it too late to participate? No, it is not too late. All incoming gifts will be part of the supplemental support in my general fund from which I receive my monthly support. Early in January I will write the final PRESS Fund letter 2025-2026 with the grand total of funding. Thank you so much, my dear partners. I am truly overwhelmed with your generosity.
